RE: Notice of corporate reorganization and transfer of DIVCA franchise from CoxCom, LLC to Cox Communications California, LLC

Dear Mr. Morris,

CoxCom, LLC, dba Cox Communications (formerly, CoxCom, Inc.) (hereafter "Cox") is a State Video Franchise Holder and currently holds California Video Franchise No. 0003 ("DIVCA Franchise"). Pursuant to General Order 169, Article VI(F), this letter hereby provides notice that, as part of a corporate re-organization, CoxCom, LLC will transfer its DIVCA Franchise, to a newly formed subsidiary, Cox Communications California, LLC. Cox CA will be 100% owned by Cox. This transfer will be effective December 31, 2011.

In addition to notifying the Commission of this change, Cox is sending a separate notice to each of the affected Local Entities.

Cox requests that the Commission issue an updated California Video Franchise Certificate that reflects Cox Communications California, LLC as the holder of the DIVCA Franchise.
