In accordance with California's Digital Infrastructure Video Competition Act (DIVCA), Cox Communications California L.L.C., doing business as Cox Communications, respectfully submits the following amendment to our existing state authorized Franchise Number 0003. Cox Communications seeks to amend its video license to include a limited area within the **unincorporated** region of **Orange County**, with the state video franchise. The unincorporated area of Orange County being requested for inclusion into Cox's state video franchise is a new residential project currently in development. The area being submitted is based upon current build-out requests. Additional details of the community's future streets are not yet available. This area is not currently being provided video service by Cox Communications. We respectfully request the state video franchise amendment requested for this community be effective on April 22, 2013.
