



Dan Cross-Call, Manager, Rocky Mountain Institute. Dan Cross-Call is a Manager with RMI's electricity practice. He works on electric utility strategy, regulatory policy, retail electricity pricing, and community energy strategy. Dan also supports RMI's Electricity Innovation Lab (eLab), a unique multi-year collaboration of leading industry actors to develop, implement, and spread new solutions to enable greater adoption of economic distributed energy resources. Highlights of his work include launching the annual eLab Accelerator meeting, which convenes leading electricity innovation projects from around the country to accelerate their projects, and managing RMI's partnership with the New York Department of Public Service as advisors on the Reforming the Energy Vision (REV) proceeding.

Prior to RMI, Dan worked as a consultant in the energy practice of Charles River Associates in Boston. At CRA, he worked on electricity-related projects including energy and capacity market models for power plant valuations in U.S. Northeast markets, analysis of proposed legislation and regulatory rule changes, transmission development studies, and strategic planning for RTO wind integration. He conducted studies of all of major North American deregulated electricity markets and performed modeling and research of European and Middle East electricity systems.
