Pursuant to Assembly Bill 327 (Perea, 2013), the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) adopted the current NEM structure, often referred to as “NEM 2.0” or the “NEM successor tariff,” through the NEM 2.0 Decision (D.16-01-044) in January 2016. The Decision requires the CPUC and its Energy Division to consider adjustments to the NEM 2.0 tariff in the future.

The CPUC Decision on NEM consumer protections (D.18-09-044) authorizes ratepayer funding for a consultant to conduct a formal and independent evaluation of NEM 2.0 to analyze the costs and benefits of customer-sited renewable resources taking service on the tariff and its variants. The evaluation will assist the CPUC in revisiting NEM 2.0 by examining the effects of the tariff. Following a competitive bid process, the CPUC selected Itron to perform the evaluation.

Itron, in consultation with Energy Division staff, has prepared a draft research plan for the NEM 2.0 evaluation. This draft research plan was distributed to the service list for Rulemaking (R.)14-07-002 on November 27, 2019. The purpose of this meeting is to present the draft research plan and solicit feedback from interested stakeholders.
