Subject: Annual Risk Spending Accountability Report Energy Division 2022 Review Schedule and Extension Notification

Dear Service List Recipients:

In preparation for the Risk Spending Accountability Report (RSAR) Review, Energy Division provides the 2022 Annual RSAR Review Schedule below, in accordance with Table 5 [D.19-04-020](#).

In April of 2019, the CPUC issued D.19-04-020 establishing the requirements for the RSARs. By April 10 of each year, the decision requires the Energy Division to submit a letter providing that year's Annual RSAR Review Schedule to the investor-owned utilities and parties in relevant open GRC proceedings and post the schedule on the Commission website.

- a) If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, it is extended to the following business day.
- b) SCE request an extension of the submittal on January 12, 2022 the Executive Director granted the extension in a letter dated January 21, 2022
- c) SoCal Gas and SDG&E requested an extension on the December 12, 2021 and the Executive Director granted the extension in a letter dated January 21, 2022
- d) Extension requested by Energy Division and herein granted with this letter

The Energy Division requested a 40-day extension for the review of the PG&E RSAR from June 19, 2022 to July 29, 2022. The extension was requested due to the overlap of the PG&E general rate case review and the inability to shift the PG&E review because of the other IOU submittal extensions. This letter also acts as approval on the extensions.
