CPUC Accelerates Climate Credit to Assist Those Experiencing High Natural Gas Prices Throughout California

Every year the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) tracks natural gas prices in preparation for the winter. Since early December, natural gas prices have tripled due to a variety of factors including early cold weather in the Western states. The cost of natural gas is paid by utilities and that cost is passed directly to utility customers. As the cost of natural gas paid by the utilities rose, residents throughout the state were faced with higher energy bills. These high bills could continue if these market conditions persist.

While the CPUC does not regulate natural gas prices or natural gas producers, given the impact of the high prices on utility customers, and given the role that natural gas plays in electricity production, the CPUC has taken immediate actions to address the issue. Upon seeing the price spikes in December, the CPUC promptly directed utilities to enhance customer communications via email, social media, customer calls, bill inserts, community based organizations, television spots, and even text messages to those enrolled in text communications. This includes information on enrolling in income qualified



programs like [CARE](#) and [FERA](#), enrolling in seasonal billing plans to stabilize monthly bills, opting into rate forecast tools, and strategies to safely conserve while retaining health, comfort, and safety during the holidays.

The CPUC also acted quickly to provide much needed support to customers experiencing unusually high natural gas bills this winter by accelerating the timeframe in which residential energy customers will receive a Climate Credit on their bills. The combined Climate Credit of roughly \$90 to \$120 will automatically show up as soon as possible, rather than in April, on the bills of customers of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison, San Diego Gas & Electric, and Southern California Gas Company. Customers of Bear Valley, Liberty, PacifiCorp, and Southwest Gas will also receive an accelerated credit. For specific amounts, please visit the CPUC's [website](#). Equity Initiatives and Clean Energy Access Grant Program Webinar

Please join the CPUC on **FEBRUARY 15, 2023, FROM 10 A.M. – NOON** for an informational webinar on the draft Equity Initiatives and Clean Energy Access Grant Program.

Assembly Bill 179 (Ting, Chapter 249, Statutes of 2022) provided \$30 million in funding to expand the scope of public participation to include community-based organizations that have not historically engaged in matters before the CPUC.

The purpose of the grant funding is to increase the breadth and depth of voices providing input to the CPUC on issues affecting them, especially those in diverse and low-income communities, hard to reach customers, tribal communities, individuals with access and functional needs, and frontline communities experiencing the impacts of climate change.

During the webinar, which is free and open to the public, CPUC staff will provide an overview of the draft grant program, and a Q&A session will provide attendees with an opportunity to share their opinions and ask questions on the issues discussed.

A big welcome to the CPUC's newest Commissioner, Karen Douglas!

Commissioner Douglas was appointed to the CPUC by Governor Gavin Newsom on Dec. 22, 2022. She was sworn in as a Commissioner on Jan. 13, 2023, by CPUC President Alice Reynolds.

Commissioner Douglas was previously Senior Advisor for Energy in the Office of Governor Newsom since 2022. She was a member of the California Energy Commission from 2008 to 2022. She was Director of the California Climate Initiative for the Environmental Defense Fund from 2005 to 2008. She held several positions at the Planning and Conservation League from 2001 to 2005, including Acting Executive Director and General Counsel. Commissioner Douglas earned a Juris Doctor degree from Stanford Law School and a Master of Public Policy degree in

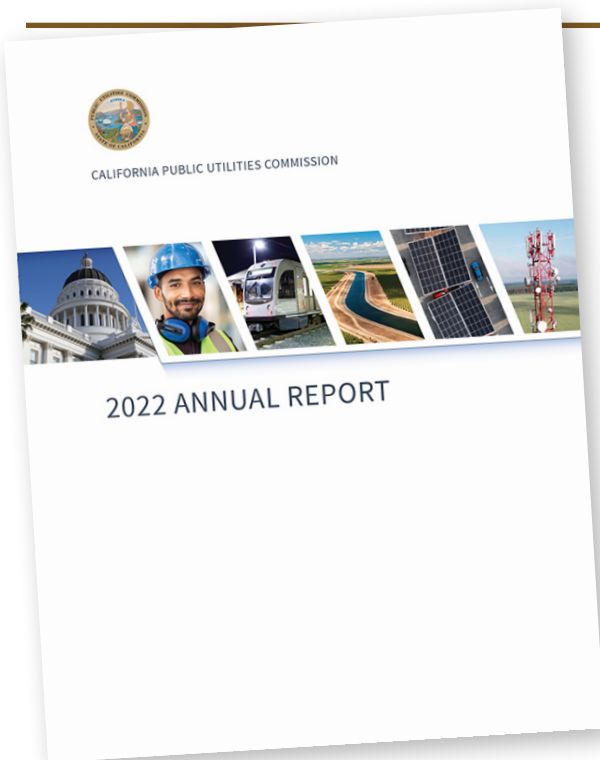


CPUC President Reynolds and Commissioner Douglas at the swearing in ceremony, Jan. 13, 2023.

program that requires power plants and other large industries that emit greenhouse gases to buy carbon pollution permits from auctions managed by the California Air Resources Board. The credit on the electricity bills of consumers represents the consumer's share of the payments from the State's program.

Further, on Feb. 7, 2023, the CPUC held an online En Banc in coordination with the California Energy Commission and the California Independent System Operator to examine the causes and impacts of the high natural gas prices. Additionally, given this is a West-wide issue, the CPUC is communicating with other Western states on opportunities to work together on this issue to bring stability for customers. ■

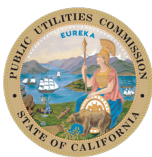
