**PURPOSE**

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code 8386(d), San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby submits this Tier 1 Advice Letter (AL) to the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) as notification that SDG&E has incurred costs exceeding its authorized annual revenue requirement for vegetation management for fiscal year 2022.

**PROTEST**

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be submitted electronically and must be received no later than August 1, 2022, which is 21 days of the date of this Advice Letter was submitted with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may submit a protest.


